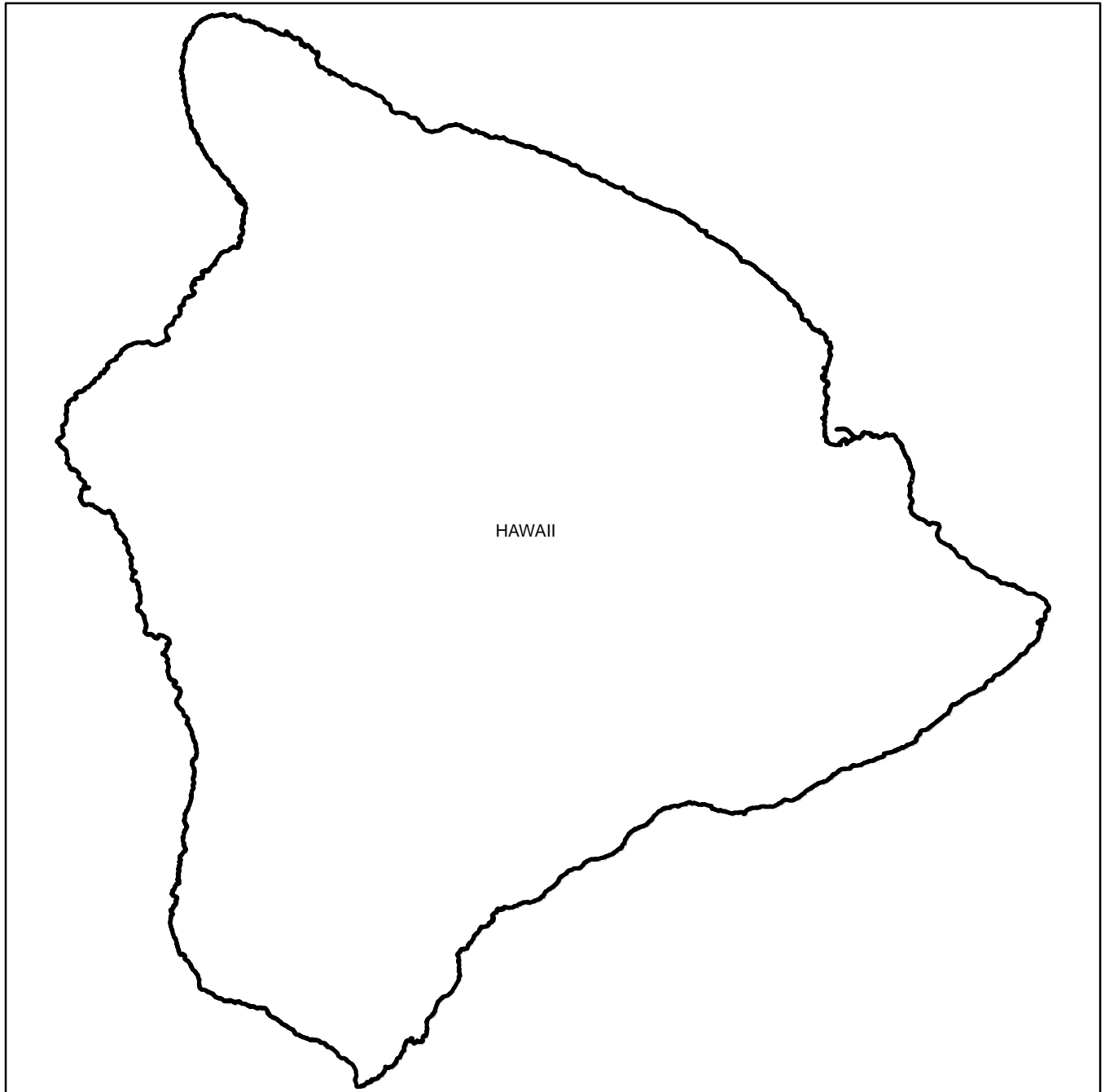

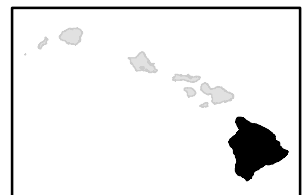

HONOLULU

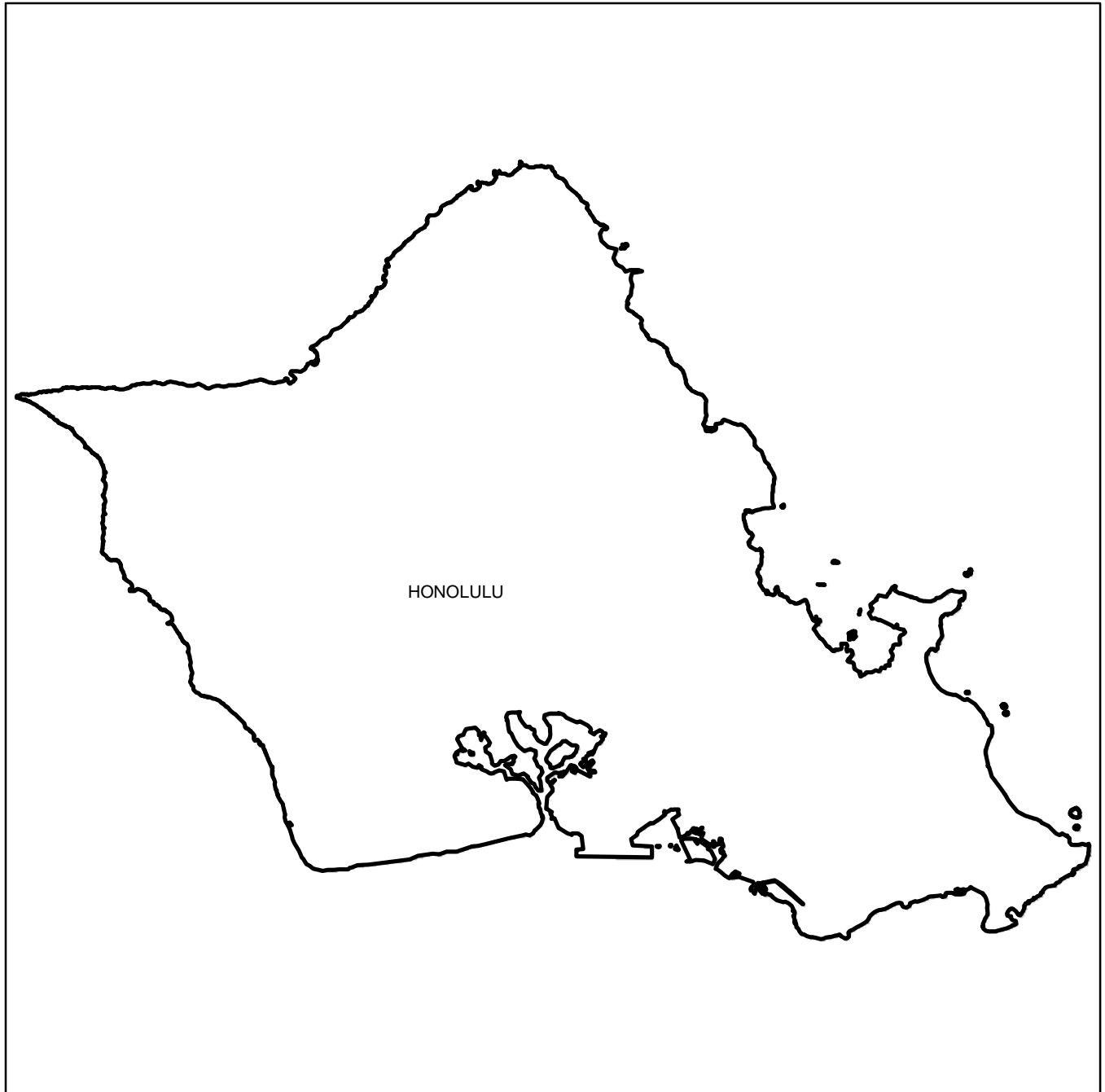
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4/30/1907 - 12/31/2000

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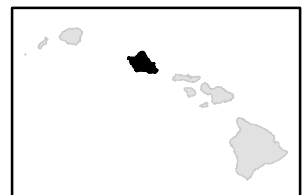
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HONOLULU created from all of OAHU when the "City and County of Honolulu" was incorporated; OAHU county eliminated.

KALAWAO

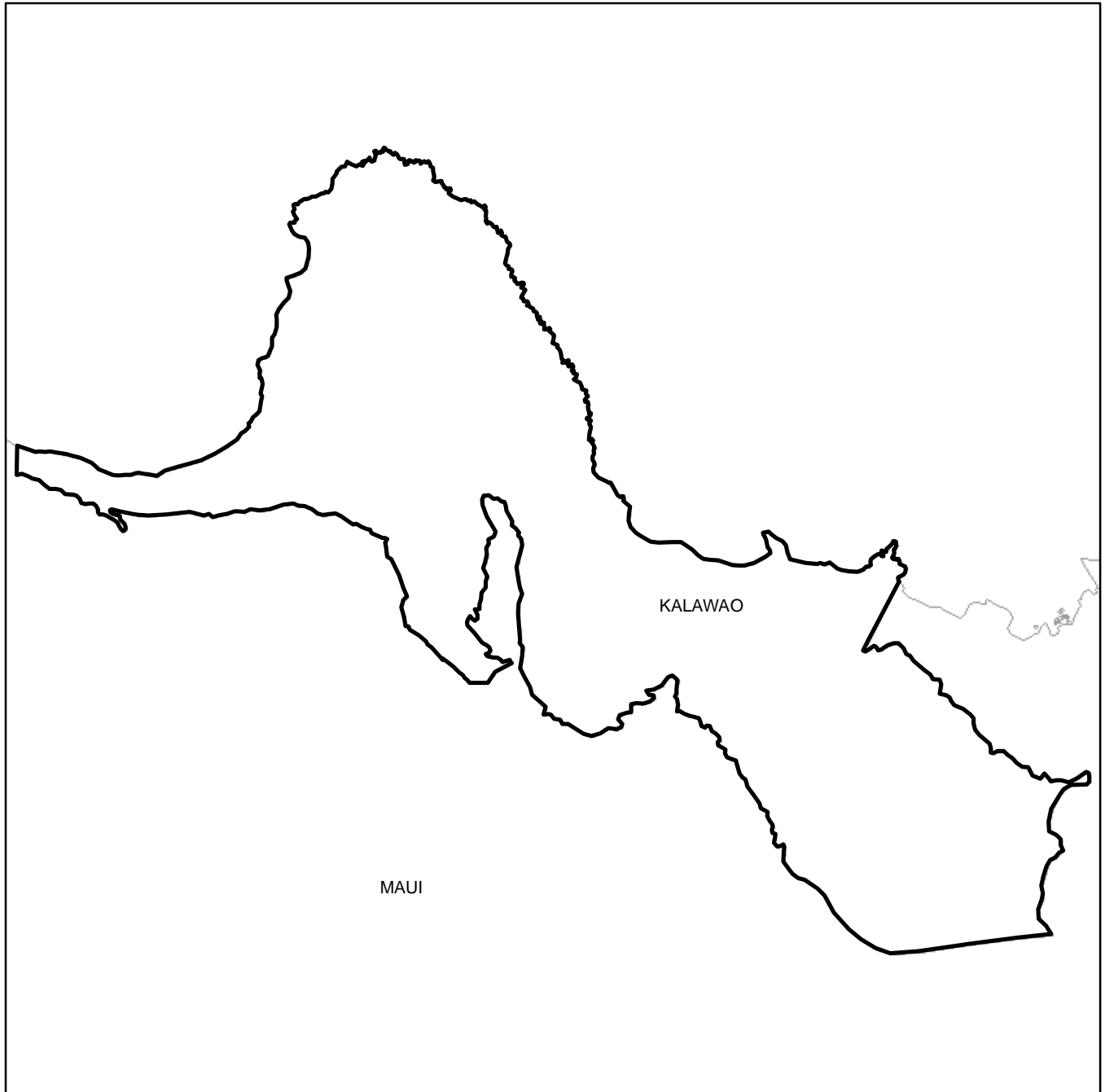
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4/22/1903 - 12/31/2000

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Base map shows present-day information.

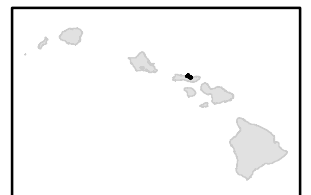
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KALAWAO created by the Territory of Hawaii from that portion of the island of Molokai known as Kalaupapa, Kalawao, and Waikolu; commonly designated as the Leper Settlement. KALAWAO was under the direct jurisdiction and control of the Board of Health.

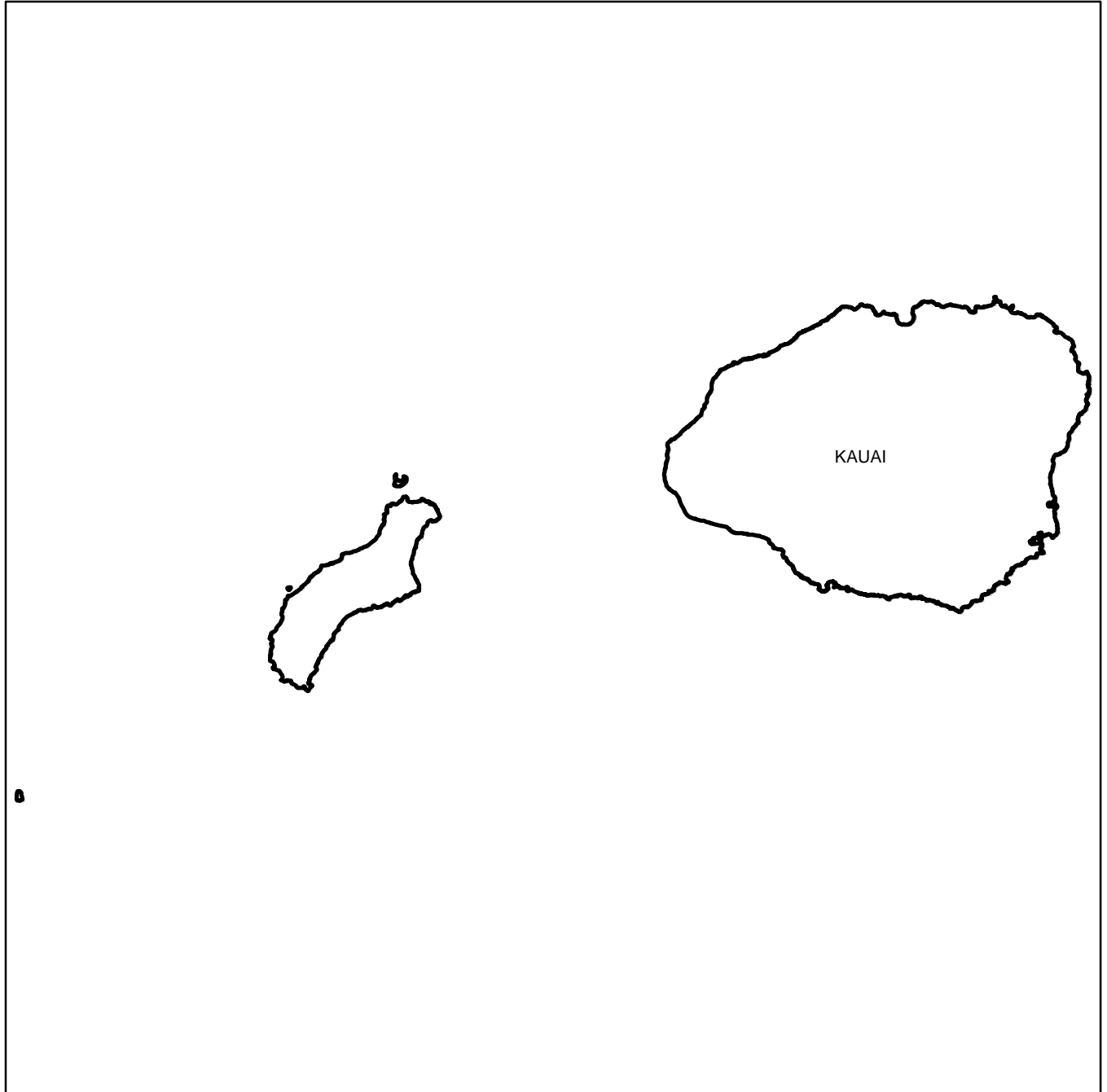

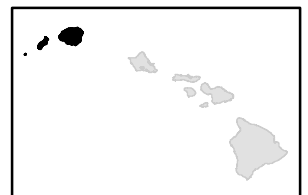
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KAUAI created by the Territory of Hawaii from the islands of Kauai and Niihau, all other islands within three nautical miles thereof, and the waters adjacent thereto.

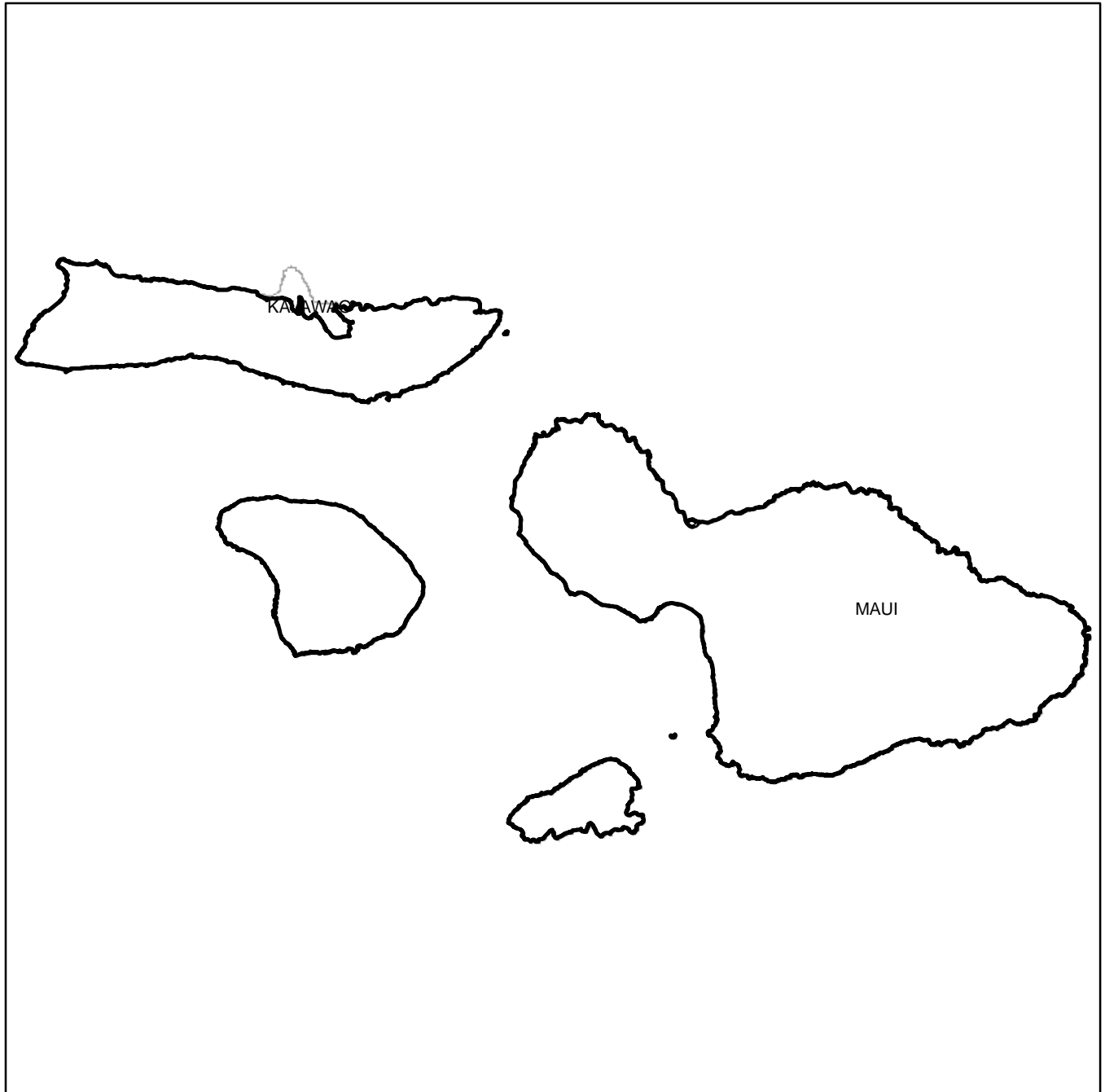

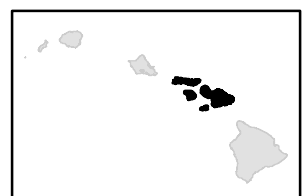

EAST HAWAII (extinct)

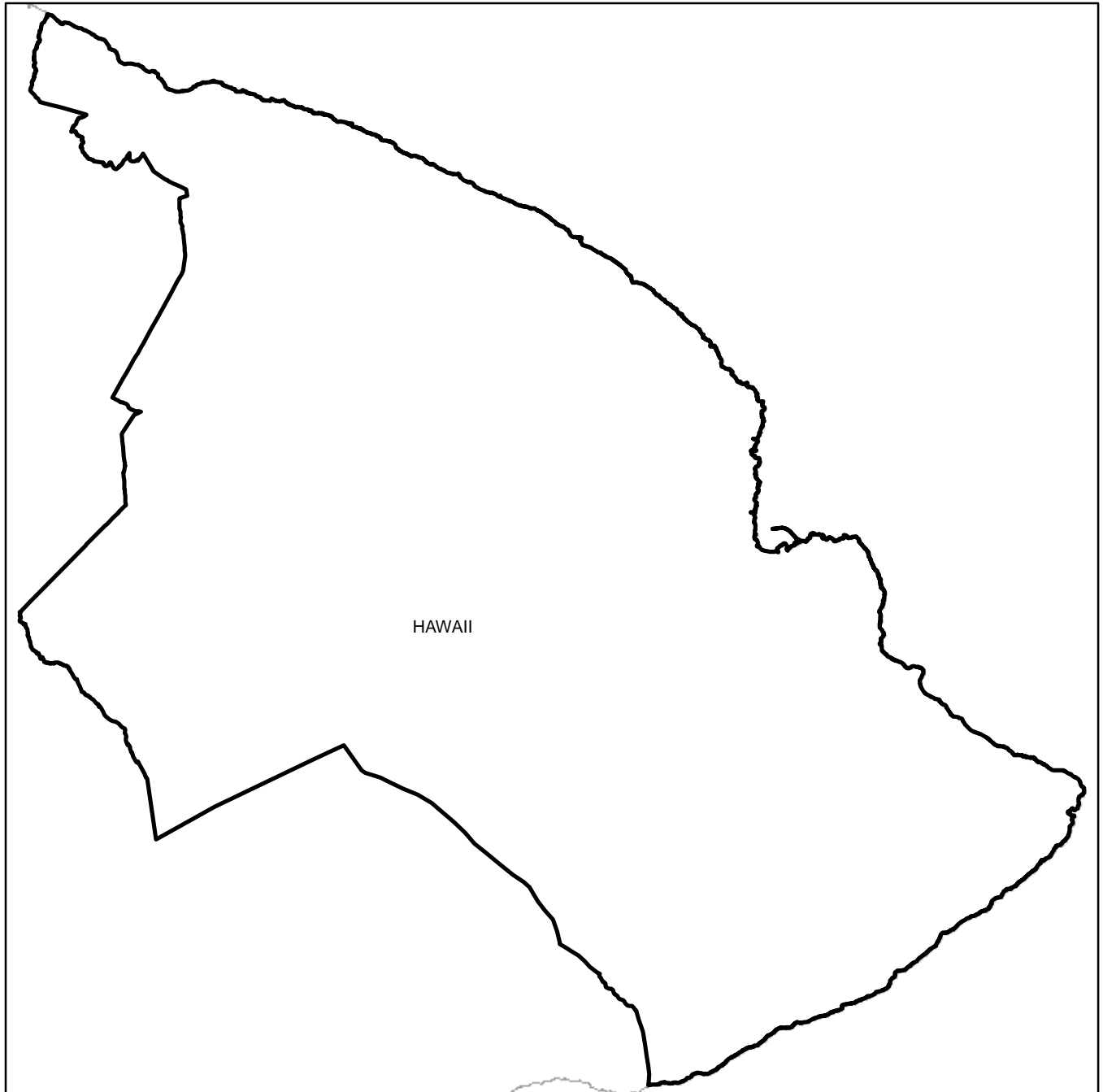

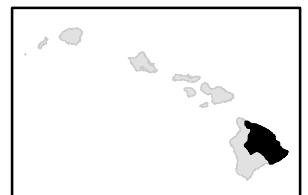

OAHU (extinct)

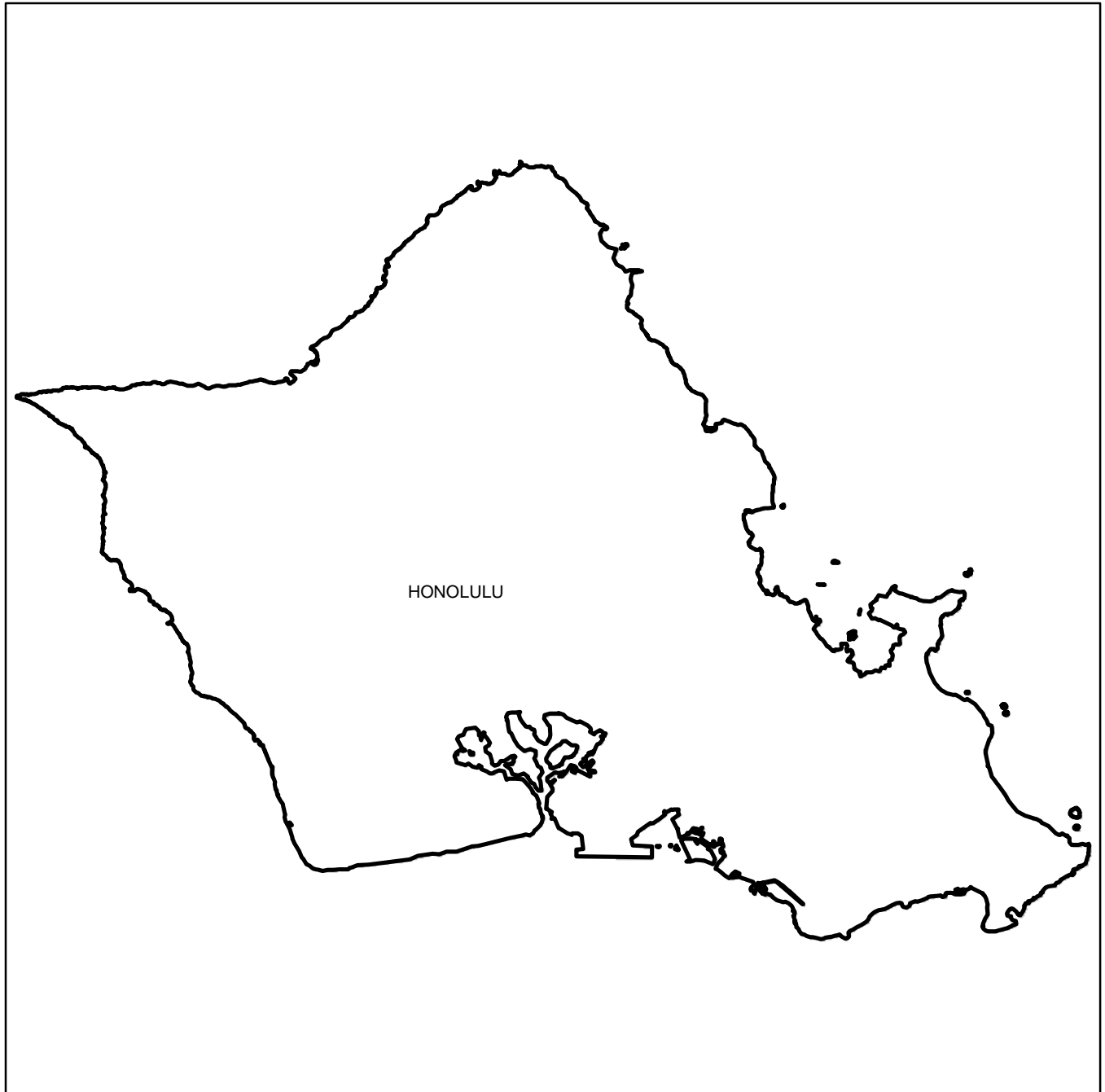

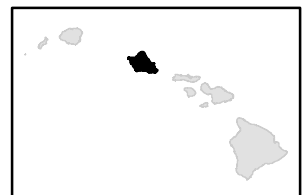

WEST HAWAII (extinct)

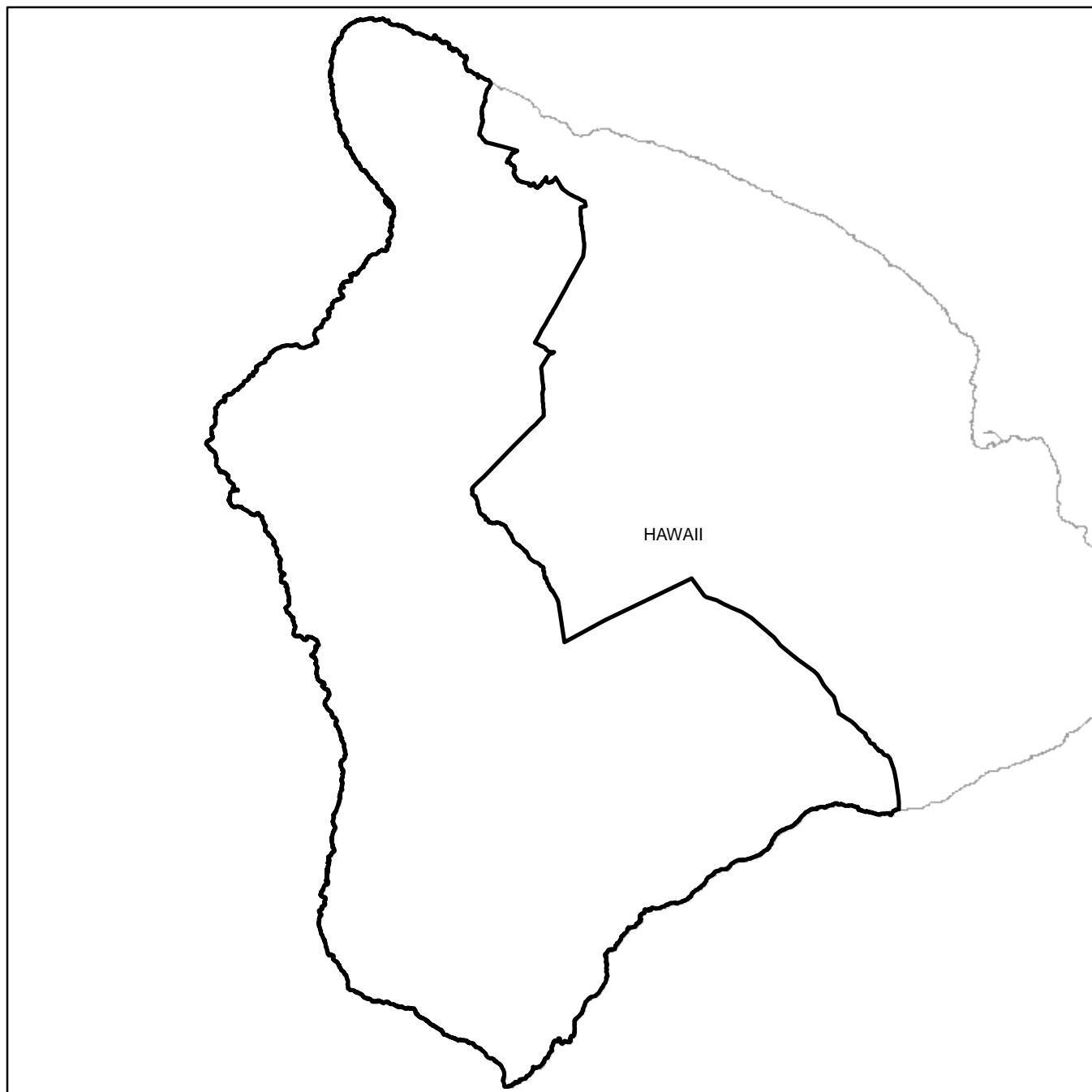
